2008 Pinot Gris

This 2008 Pinot Gris is the embodiment of a summer walk through a flowering peach orchard. Experience the slight honey quality, a bit of green apple and even crisp Anjou Pear aromas. Your palate is in for a clean crisp finish with an enticing minerality.

FATTOUSH

Grape tomatoes, Persian cucumbers, kalamata olives, red radishes, red onions, garlic, fresh cilantro, basil, parsley, mint, chives, feta cheese, whole wheat pita strips, toasted cumin seeds, Aleppo pepper, EVOL red wine vinegar, lemon juice dressing over mixed greens

2008 Rosé of Sangiovese

The bud breaks and aromas of strawberry, watermelon, rhubarb, and yes, even rose petals entice you softly. Upon the palate the flavor blooms and you experience the flavors that the bouquet suggested, adding pie cherries and a suggestion of fruit compote. This summer sipper is a perfect refresher on a warm day providing a lush mouth-feel and delightfully crisp finish.

Lechazo Asado

Slow roasted basil pesto encrusted lamb chops, Gorgonzola, poblano and spinach smashed potatoes, ratatouille

2008 Winemakers Red

This Winemaker's Red shows a clear, bright, ruby-red color. The aromas hearken to its predecessor with Caramel, a bit of dark berry and cherry and a hint of smoke and lilac. On the palate a medium to light acidity comes through as cranberry to compliment the caramel, coffee and bits of chocolate.

Cr@Vic

2005 Cabernet Sauvignon

Enticing aromas of dark cherry and raspberry mingle with hints of eucalyptus and fresh bark. On the palate the rich delivery of the same combines with cranberry, coffee, smatterings of sour apple, caramel and even a bit of anise. This Cab lover's dream is a shining example of a Pacific Northwest fruit forward gem.
