Focaccia De La Provincia

Open faced focaccia bread with fresh basil, fresh mozzarella, garlic ,
EVOO and thinly sliced portabello mushrooms.

Balsamic Steak Salad

Grilled steak tossed in EVOO, balsamic vinegar with roasted red peppers, scallions,
tomatoes, mushrooms, red cabbage, artichoke hearts and sunflower seeds with romaine lettuce

Pasta Rustica

Mild Italian sausage & shrimp with zucchini, mushrooms,
sweet red peppers in basil-pesto cream with ziti noodles.

Pork Molise

Grilled pork tenderloin, wrapped in bacon, roasted garlic, horseradish mashed potatoes,
honey caramelized onions and apricot - dark cherry sauce

Dangerous Dilemma

Fudgy dark chocolate cake, with a white chocolate
cream layer finished with a raspberry liqueur sauce

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2008 Flowers Sonoma Coast Chardonnay \$ 40

Showing balanced depth and complexity, light straw to golden color. White peach and lime citrus aromas. A clean wine with lean acidity refreshes the palate. Stone minerals and luscious melon equally contend for attention in this mouth filling, delicious wine.

2005 Sebastiani Dutton Ranch Russian River Valley Chardonnay \$ 40

Medium gold in color, this wine has lovely aromas of toast, butter, marzipan, peaches and pears. In the mouth, it flaunts flavors of Golden Delicious apple and Meyer lemon. The wine's body is medium to full with silky elegance and roundness. It is a riche

2009 Merry Edwards Winery Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir \$ 60

Deep ruby colour; intense, spicy plum, smoke and leather nose; sweet fruit, full on the palate with a lively spine of acidity, well-integrated oak and ripe tannins.

2009 "Sea Smoke" Southing" Santa Barbara Pinot Noir \$ 75

The seductive nose of the Sea Smoke Pinot Noir Southing 2009 exhibits fresh leather, rose water, black cherry, violets and hint of macerated cherry. The fine tannins and minerality are enhanced by our estate vineyards characteristic cool climate acidity.

2009 Orin Swift Cellars Saldo Zinfandel \$ 32

The 2009 Saldo bursts with aromas of ripe strawberry and black fruits with well integrated oak. The entry is mouth coating and leads into a mid palate with structure and good acidity. The finish is bright and long with soft tannins and subtle oak sweetness.

2009 Turley Zinfandel Old Vine \$ 45

The Zinfandel Old Vines is a blend of declassified wine from Turley's old-vine vineyards. A great buy and one of the best old-vine cuvees the Turleys have produced, rich full-bodied, and unctuously textured, it explodes from the glass revealing black fruits, earth, kirsch, licorice, pepper, and underbrush elements. Sweet (from glycerin and high alcohol, not sugar), dry, full-bodied, concentrated, hedonistic, and supple,

2010 Molly Dooker Blue Eyed Boy Shiraz \$ 50

'Smooth and velvety, with depth and a distinctive range of flavors, offering a minty edge to the black cherry, plum and spice, coming together smoothly on the polished finish..

2007 Fess Parker Winery "Rodney's Vineyard" Syrah \$ 46

Layers of boysenberry, blueberry, black pepper and smoked meat mingle with sage, all spice and bacon on the nose. An irresistible combination of flavors including blueberry, plum, cassis, dark chocolate, vanilla and dried herbs are truly pleasing on the palate.

2004 Galante "Blackjack Pasture" Cabernet Sauvignon \$ 60

The "Blackjack Pasture" is our signature wine and our most powerful and exclusive cabernet sauvignon from a tiny 2.4 acre parcel that produces very small yields and intensely colored small berried grapes. Every vintage sees 100% new french oak to match the massive black fruit this vineyard gives. This opulent and thick cab has currant and blackberry flavors with lush chocolate notes.

2005 Charles Krug Family Reserve Generations \$ 50

"Very plush and lush, offering deep, ripe flavors of blackberries, currants, cassis, violets, herbs and smoky cedar, wrapped into firm tannins. Should develop gracefully over the next 8-10 years. The wine is a Bordeaux blend with a splash of Syrah, which seems to add a meaty note. "
